Do you know about the \$12 million plan to destroy one of Houston's last natural stretches of Buffalo Bayou?

The Harris County Flood District has received a permit to raze the trees, dredge, fill, and reroute one of the last remaining natural stretches of Buffalo Bayou as it flows past Memorial Park. This project violates best management practices for riparian areas and *will destroy the bayou's ecosystem.*
